Perth Museum is a brand new £26.5 million redevelopment of a beautiful historic building in the centre of Perth City, featuring a purpose-built interior designed to house the Stone of Destiny, also known as the Stone of Scone, one of Scotland and the UK's most significant historical objects. The Museum opened its doors in Spring 2024 and offers visitors a 5*, fully accessible and captivating experience that inspires them to explore Scotland's past and its connection to the wider world through its display of exceptional objects representing natural history, social history, and world cultures. Perth Museum will feature an exciting and memorable programme of unique experiences for DMCs, groups and FITs, including private guided tours of the museum and the Stone outwith normal opening hours.

Perth Museum is proud to be sourcing sustainable, locally produced and Stone-inspired items that will be available in our on-site shop, whilst our café will invite guests to indulge in fantastic Scottish fare in a brand-new space.

Our sister property – Perth Art Gallery – also recently relaunched in spring 2023 and is home to the region's Recognised Collections of National Significance. Guests will have a rare opportunity to get behind-the-scenes at this beautiful venue and tour our extensive Collections Store, home to items that are currently not on display.

After a meet and greet, clients will be taken on a tour of the highlights to be found in the museum with one of our on-site guides.
